The fourth edition of the European Geoparks Week is dedicated to the landscape of Naturtejo Geopark. 40 events occurring in all the municipalities of the territory made from the Landscape Festival 2010 a starting success. This year's edition is marked by the strong support of municipalities, villages, local NGO's and sport clubs, and Tourism of Centre Region. During three weeks, between May 22 and June 13 there are trekking and mountain bike activities, educational programs, workshops with Living Science Centre of Forest, special visits to DinoExpo and to "Travelling Dinos", exhibitions, parties and events celebrating the International Year of Biodiversity. In this period of time a new way of tourism with GPS, the "geocaching", will be emphasized with special events letting know the "caches" already existent at the Geopark. Also, the winners of the school contest Climate Change and Biodiversity will be found by the Geopark.

Landscape Festival starts with the celebration of the International Day of Biodiversity. On 23rd Estreito Trails is launched as a new tourist footpath for the Geopark, and the 4th of Oleiros municipality. The Apiarist's Day is celebrated with the exhibition "In the Kingdom of Bees" at Proença-a-Nova.

Once again, Oleiros municipality gets deeply involved with the European Geoparks Week. On the 28th the World's Day of Energy is celebrated taking the students to a wind farm. The night of 29th is fueled with geoshots in the GeoParty at Açude Pinto fluvial beach. During the same weekend the Lamb Festival of Rosmaninhal promisses to connect Mediterranean cultures through gastronomy. celebrating 500 years of the town. June starts with the Children's Day, promoting environmental fest at Idanha-a-Nova. The photo contest "Ruralities" is exposed at the Gallery of Oleiros. The Environment's Day is celebrated with cinema at Oleiros and in Living Science Centre of Forest. The 5th Orvalho Geotrail is ready for the success of former editions, but paying more attention to minimize ecological footprint. Astronomy and sunrise is promised for Corgas geosite, waking up this ancient landscape. On 6th, a mountain bike tour pretends to connect the geosites of Orvalho village. Starting on 10th, the almost 300 km mountain race Trip-Trail Geopark Naturtejo will cross the Geopark and unify the six municipalities. This European Geoparks Week ends on 13th in Penha Garcia with the "Water Trails from Monfortinho" by walking or riding horses, following the mountain to the borderland Termas de Monfortinho. For finishing this most important annual event for EGN, nothing better than the promise of a relaxing hydro massage at the thermal spa. With such a European Geoparks Week calendar and so frenetic moment, we should deserve to relax...

May – Internships at DinoExpo. During May, Elisabete Mendes, a student from the course Rural and Environmental Tourism of the Commercial and Industrial Association from Castelo Branco made her final formation, in working context, at the Educational Area of DinoExpo, collaborating not only with Educational Programs but also with general public and disabled visitors. In the beginning of May, Elisabete visited the exhibition with her teacher and colleagues and proposed herself to make here her internship. Elísio Milheiro and Pedro Valente from Idanha-a-Nova Secondary School are in the 2nd year of the course Environment Management and also made their working context formation in the Educational Area. They boosted the Educational Digging Site and other practical activities. 1437 students participated in Dino.Expo educational programs only this month!

1-2nd May – I Flower Festival at Aldeia de Santa Margarida. Naturtejo Geopark supported the first edition of the Flower Festival, where people from Aldeia de Santa Margarida ornamented the streets with colourful flowers and more than 60 professionals presented and sold their traditional products and handcraft. Traditional sounds were also played for hundreds.





2nd May – II TTransGeopark 2010: from the Zêzere to Tejo rivers. TTransGeopark of this year rolled over the spectacular tracks from the north of the Geopark, exploding of colors. Participants came from the south of Portugal to (re)discover a region with the help

of trained eyes. The organization of Casa do Forno and Naturtejo Geopark, including Carlos Neto de Carvalho, João Geraldes and Joana Rodrigues guided the participants to this ecological adventure.

This adventure, a mix of apprenticeship and environmental consciousness, betting on local resources, outstanding landscapes and minimization of the ecological footprint of tourist activity, started from the Schist Village of Álvaro. A very generous breakfast was provided by Oleiros County, with regional products and geo-cookies. After a visit to the village, the group departed to Orvalho following up to Zêzere river. Orvalho received TTransGeopark with a lunch at the geomorphological viewpoint of Cabeço Mosqueiro.

Participants crossed all the Gardunha range, between shales and granites, always with vast horizons. The end of the stage was in Ninho do Açor ethnographic museum, where a local winery prepared wine tasting. Dinner was marked by the geo-gastronomy of Casa do Forno and after, time to discover by foot the smuggling trails of Salvaterra do Extremo into the darkness of Erges Canyon geosite.

Next morning was made of fascinating landscapes along the Tejo Internacional Natural Park, between Segura and Rosmaninhal. Monforte da Beira received the off-road adventurers. Aldeia em Movimento local association prepared olive oil tasting and delicious biological cheese from a local farm.

With the support of locals, TTransGeopark reveals the best places of the Geopark, giving use to old tracks. The ecological footprint is always mitigated by environmental education initiatives such as planting of autochthonous trees, contributing for sustainable tourism.





3rd May – **Opening of the "Travelling Dinos" at Proença-a-Nova.** The "Travelling Dinos" is already a huge success. As a part of DinoExpo, this smaller exhibition aims to reach everybody by being closer in the small towns of Naturtejo Geopark, supporting also local initiatives. For 20 days dinosaurs invaded Proença-a-Nova and were visited by the whole schools from the area. The commitment of Proença-a-Nova was great so the exhibition received many visitors during the 1st Science and Technology Fair. The "Travelling Dinos" was launched with the presence of the President of Centre of Portugal Tourism Region,

Pedro Machado, Armindo Jacinto and João Manso, the vice-president of Naturtejo and responsible for tourism and culture at Proença-a-Nova; as well as Aart Walen, the owner of DinoExpo. A long opening visit was conducted by Carlos Neto de Carvalho.

3-5th May – Tourism Working Group gives Nature Tourism of Centre Region to Naturtejo. The Tourism Working Group is part of the Commission for Economy, Innovation and Energy Affairs from the Republic Assembly and visited the Centre region for three days. 18 deputies were chaired by the region's deputy Hortense Martins and Pedro Machado, president from Tourism of Centre Region. During this meeting, it was decided that Castelo Branco/Naturtejo Pole of the Tourism of Centre Region will manage the product Nature Tourism in this region. The new delegation of the Tourism of Centre Region will be located in Castelo Branco, including the city tourism office and Naturejo Geopark administrative office.

6th May – **Environmental Geology learned at the Geopark.** 50 students, master students, PhD. Students and professors from the University of Lisbon visited the Geopark in a field trip organized for the courses of Exploitation and Management of Groundwater Resources and Land Management and Environmental Impact. During two days they studied management plans and projects for regional development. Armindo Jacinto provided the welcome at the headquarters of Naturtejo Geopark, Centro Cultural Raiano in Idanha-a-Nova, in a workshop presenting Naturtejo Geopark. Joana Rodrigues presented the geological heritage of the Geopark, as well as geoconservation measures and geotourist developments. Then, there was time for a long visit to Termas de Monfortinho sources, to learn about the hydrochemistry of the mineral waters. A short visit to the Ichnological Park of Penha Garcia made by Carlos Neto de Carvalho resumed the importance of the geological heritage of the Geopark.

During the next day, Carlos Neto de Carvalho was also the catalyst for discussions about the protection of Portas de Almourão, with municipal technicians. The Declaration of Environmental Impact for the building of Alvito Dam was deeply discussed, as well as the change of place to save the geomonument. At Portas de Almourão the main subject was the economic opportunities created by environmental management, the pollution of Tejo

river and the Spanish policies of water use. According to Sara Cura, from ProTejo Movement Tejo river is being drained by Spanish Government resulting in the lost of quality of waters, lost of potential for energy production, and use in agriculture and tourism. The last workshop was accomplished at Nisa, with the support of the municipality, and several NGO's against the exploitation of the uranium ore. Discussion reached the climax with the presentation of sustainable alternatives to mining, in the scope of 21 Agenda.

Naturtejo Geopark educational programs are being enriched by the experience of partner institutions, contributing for an education more adjusted to reality in a region with exceptional conditions for apprenticeship.



7th May – **Opening of the exhibition**

"Biodiversity from Portas de Ródão Natural Monument". The municipality of Vila Velha de Ródão organized a photo exhibition in the House of Arts and Culture of Tejo. Several photographers of the region shared with the public their views concerning wildlife at Portas de Ródão Natural Monument, promoting it in the national contest New 7 Natural Wonders. Also exhibited was the work of local students and Prof. Graça Passos that won the national school contest "Wood near you" from Living Science, included in the celebrations of the International Year of Biodiversity.



Inselberg. Festivities in honour of the Divine Holy Cross had this year the support of Naturtejo Geopark, with thousands of participants. The Templar village of Monsanto was

well dressed for the celebrations that included medieval dinners and market with 140 tents selling local products, fire works, local music, street theatre and revivals with 90 actors. The origin of the village, dated back to 1165, was recreated by a series of street theatre plays, including the conquest of Monsanto to Moorish by Afonso Henriques, the first king of Portugal, and subsequent donation to the Templar Order, leading to build a powerful castle by the Master D. Gualdim Pais and the establishment of a municipality in 1174. On Sunday, there was Boulders Trail and the traditional picnic at the top of the castle, from where the legendary pot with flowers is dropped.





8th May – 5th International Mountain Bike Marathon of Idanha-a-Nova. It was impressive to assist to 1200 bikers participating in the Marathon of 100 km connecting Idanha-a-Nova with the Spanish town of Zarza la Mayor, next to the borderland. This event counted with the support of Naturtejo Geopark, where bikers cycled in the immensity of the plains and were astonished by the beauty of geosites such as Monsanto inselberg or Erges canyon, at Salvaterra do Extremo. 9th May – Kayaking against

indifference. The organizations from both sides of the national border in defense of Tejo prepared a special event to ask for sustainable management of Tejo hydrographic basin, and counted with the support of Naturtejo Geopark. From the Spanish village of Cedillo to Portas de Ródão Natural Monument, 80 people and 30 boats paddled down the river to present and sign the Chart against Indifference in front of hundreds of people from the municipalities of Vila Velha de Ródão and Nisa. This Chart asks for the application of the Water Directive for the quality of Tejo waters, support of the fluvial ecosystems, and the refuse of the transport of Tejo waters for other hydrographic basins to be used in intensive agriculture, drastically decreasing Tejo flow and consequent increasing pollution. This event counted with the support of United Photo Press/2010 – International Year of Biodiversity.



10th May – **Educational program at the Ichnological Park of Penha Garcia.** Jácome Ratton high school came for a full day at Naturtejo Geopark. 53 students and 5 teachers enjoyed the Ichnological Park of Penha Garcia with Manuela Catana and Catarina Loureiro.


10-19th May – **Dutch holidays discovering the Geopark.** Oliva Travel operating from Holland is responsible for the Dutch discover of the Geopark. One more couple came for a long distance walking discovering the most precious natural and cultural wonders from Idanha-a-Nova region.

11th May – **High school Spanish students visit the Geopark.** João Geraldes was the "teacher" for 18 students and 2 teachers from Valle Ambroz, between the granite morphologies of Monsanto inselberg and the trace fossils from the Ichnological Park of Penha Garcia.

12-14th May – **Nature**, **Culture and Adventure at Naturtejo Geopark**. Champagnat College from Lisbon prepared the annual school trip at Naturtejo Geopark. 147 pupils and 18 teachers were organized by Naturtejo and Incentivos Outdoor for outdoor activities during three days. The first day was for visiting Portas de Ródão Natural Monument and the Tejo Valley, including the already famous boat trip to the geomonumento and the visit to the Fossil Trees. At the end of the day a Griffon Vulture was released at Portas de Almourão geomonument.

Second day was time for the Ichnological Park of Penha Garcia: casting fossils at the Palaeozoic Museum and climbing the quartzite beds, besides donkey and horse riding. They also visited the historical village of Idanha-a-Velha. The last day was for discovering DinoExpo.

14th May – **Dinosaurs and Fossils Route at the Geopark.** 31 visitors from ALTRAN Portugal visited DinoExpo and the Ichnological Park of Penha Garcia with Tiago Oliveira.







14-16th May – Successful Science and Technology Fair of Proença-a-Nova. The I Science and Technology Fair was organized by the Living Science Centre and Proença-a-Nova county, right in the town centre. Many Science Centres from other towns and cities from Portugal were there showing in first had scientific experiments and technological devices. Naturtejo Geopark was also invited to develop workshops for schools. "Fossils...in minutes" was a workshop of fossil casting run by Catarina Loureiro for 65 students and 7 teachers. Besides, Manuela Catana and Catarina Loureiro painted fossils with visitors, with the help of a technician from Idanha-a-Nova, Carla Nabais. Carlos Neto de Carvalho and Joana Rodrigues were invited for a "Coffee of Science" at the coffee shop to talk for the general public about the Geological Heritage from Proença-a-Nova: a legacy with more than 500 Ma".





15th May – **Accessible Tourism** – **tourism for all.** Joana Rodrigues and Carlos Neto de Carvalho were invited by Pombal county and the Portuguese Association for Natural and Rural Tourism for talking in a bar from this city about Accessibility in Education. They presented the example of the Naturtejo Geopark to general public and the Mayor of Pombal.

16th May – **Trekking on the fountains and springs.** 70 people walked 7 km at Proença-a-Velha to know more about the importance of fountains and springs. This trekking supported by Naturtejo Geopark was associated to the 8th Festival of traditional soups.



17th May - 70 students discovered the world of Geology. Joana Rodrigues returned once again to her secondary school, Augusto Gomes in Matosinhos and imagined with the help of students what causeway stones would say to us if they talk. The students from 10th and 11st grade made a virtual travel through world and national monuments, buildings, geomonuments, outcrops and protected areas, in order to undestand the value of geodiversity and the importance of its conservation.

18th May -

Government of Timor-Leste visited Naturtejo Geopark. The Minister of Tourism, Commerce and Services from Timor-Leste and deputates visited Naturtejo Geopark. The aim of the visit was to define common strategies for economical and tourist development, as well as to establish cooperation protocols. The governmental group was received at DinoExpo by the mayors of Castelo Branco and Nisa for a press conference. The Minister

signed the first document with Tourism of Centre Region with the presence of Armindo Jacinto, president of Naturtejo Geopark, for the development of a geopark project in this Portuguese-spoken country of Asia-Pacific.



of the contest "Climate changes and biodiversity". The winners of the school contest "Climate changes and Biodiversity" were presented in a press conference at DinoExpo. This contest was promoted by Naturtejo and Arouca geoparks, as well as National Commission for UNESCO, with the support of Naturtejo's municipalities and outdoor companies, for the school year 2009/10. 250 students and 11 teachers from the schools of 3 municipalities participated with 18 work projects. The ceremony occurred with the presence of the Minister of Tourism, Commerce and Industry from Timor-Leste and certificates were given to the winners of the kindergarten category and Primary/Middle school category. The first prize will take 12 students to Arouca Geopark. The seconde prize gives the possibility to 38 students to discover the Ichnological Park of Penha Garcia with adventure sports. The third prize is a boat trip to Portas de Ródão Natural Monument for 36 students. The aim of this school contest was to contribute for sensitization of scholar population for climate change and its effects for biodiversity stimulating young people for the purposes of the "Decade of Education for Sustainable Development".



18th May – Mining Guide is available online.

The Mining Guide is already available online in www.roteirodeminas.pt. This is a project of national Geological Survey to establish tourist routes among areas of special mining and geological interest. Naturtejo Geopark is one of the first 21 pioneering sites presented all over continental Portugal. All the information and events about these geotourist sites can be found at the web platform.

school II. 71 students and 3 teachers from João Roiz primary school were involved in casting fossils by Manuela Catana supported by two technicians from Idanha-a-Nova.






20th May - Casting








27th May - Geopark

National Congress of Geotourism in Venezuela: one more step towards the sustainable development of a Geopark. Fundación Geoparques de Venezuela (FGDV) hosted the 1st National Conference on Geotourism - Venezuela 2010. This conference was held in the city of Merida under the main subject "The Landscape – Tourist Resource

for Sustainable Development", with the institutional support of Naturtejo Geopark. This was a space for discussion and debate on this new approach of tourism and geoconservation spreading all over the world. 370 participants, 20 universities and 18 institutions involved, as well as 4 working sessions are evidences of the tremendous success of the Congress. The 1st National Conference on Geotourism was totally free of charge for people who are interested in participation. FGDV firmly believes in the gratuity of the education and knowledge, which represented a generous but enormous effort to find 100% sponsorship. But this remarkable example must be emphasized and copied by others. Many people came from different areas of knowledge: experts from tourism, geology, architecture, philosophy, as well as students from tourism, environmental management, biology, geology, geophysics, geochemistry, geography, architechture, and education. Also non governmental organizations, tourism companies, cooperatives, representatives of local communities, and representatives of local and regional government, even the tourism ministry participated. Around 75% of Venezuelan states were represented in this conference. According to the organizers, the 1st National Conference on Geotourism was structured in key-note talks and communications during the morning and discussion groups during the afternoon. The discussion themes were Geotourism, Geoparks, Geological and Mining Heritage, National network for the protection of Geological and Mining Heritage. Other spectacular achievements from the Congress were the development of the Geotourism National Network and a new date for the second congress, to be held in May 2011 in Yaracuy, with the support of the Corporación Yaracuyana de Turismo. Roigar López, Jesus Salazar and Francisco Furtado must be congratulated for all the successful work done and we expect that they share their results in an international meeting somewhere in the future. Well done!




29th May – **Geoparty with American sounds and "Schistshots"**. Nice evening at Oleiros! The Açude Pinto camping prepared with the municipality of Oleiros a geoparty with a special menu of shots reminding local and general geology. Oleiros "Xistoshots" were powerful combinations of alcohol and good humour. Jigsaw was the band invited from Coimbra to heat the night. The palaeontologist Vanda Santos was the special guest of this event.

29-30th May – Lamb Festival celebrates 500 years of Rosmaninhal. The two-day gastronomic festival from Rosmaninhal was an event to celebrate 500 years as a town and the cattle annual fair. Lamb tastes from Lebanon, Greece, Morocco, Spain and Portugal were experimented by hundreds of visitors, showing the Mediterranean culture through gastronomy. The trekking "Shepherds: culture of a people" was appreciated by dozens of participants guided by Eddy Chambino throughout the cultural landscapes from Rosmaninhal.

29th May-6th June - **DINO-KIDS**. The Children's week at Forum Castelo Branco mall counted with the presence of DinoExpo.
